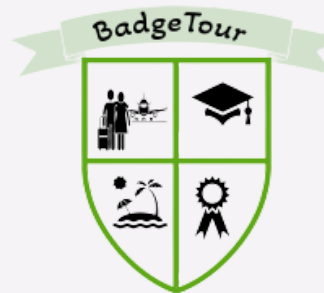

BADGETOUR INTERNATIONAL TRAINING EVENT

On May 9-11 2023, Oulu University of Applied Sciences (Oamk) organized the BadgeTour international training event in Finland. This international event was an opportunity for teachers and trainers to gain valuable knowledge of micro-credentialing in VET.

Each project partner invited two VET trainers to test the project results and particularly the e-learning course on Moodle. On the three training days the participants completed the five modules of the Moodle course and gave valuable feedback to improve the training material.

ACTIVITIES UP TO NOW

On September 21, 2023 the partners met in Spain for the 5th transnational project meeting. The meeting was hosted by INFODEF in Valladolid. The meeting focused on discussing and finalizing the main project results, including the BadgeTour Toolkit and BadgeTour Training Path.

After TPM5 the BadgeTour Moodle course has been finalized and it's ready to launch in each of the partner countries. Each partner will pilot the Moodle course with 10 VET trainers or managers. After the pilots the BadgeTour Moodle course will be open for all managers and trainers in the VET tourism sector.

WHAT'S NEXT?

As the BadgeTour project is coming to an end, all the partners are organizing multiplier events on their countries as a major part of the dissemination and sustainability strategy. VET trainers and VET organisations in the tourism sector together with associations of tourism and stakeholders in the education and VET sector will be invited to the event to hear about the BadgeTour results (R1–Guidelines, R2–Toolkit, R3–Training path). At least 25 participants will attend the event in presence and 10 online in each country.

Training 2000 (Italy) and SUPSI (Switzerland) held their events in ISS Panzini of Senigallia during the Erasmus Days on October 2023. This event leaves us with the certainty that microcredentials and their potential as a form of recognition of skills and learning experiences need to be explored at local, national and European levels. The BadgeTour closing meeting will be held in Italy in November 2023. Stay tuned for more updates!
